However, the most successful students in are not only competent readers but active, engaged readers. How does it affect our decisions about smoking, drinking, and drug use? Write down your questions and use them to test yourself on the reading. You clearly identify main concepts, key details, and their relationships with one another. Most of your writing assignments—“from brief response papers to in-depth research projects”—will depend on your understanding of course reading assignments or related readings you do on your own. Speak up in class, schedule a meeting with your instructor, or visit your university learning centre for assistance.

Practical uses Any material that requires evaluation. You read to remember at least 75 to 80 percent of the information. Deal with the problem as early in the semester as you can. Questions of ownership and control are central — a relatively small number of individuals control what we watch, read and hear in the media. While it may seem that this strategy of four reading stages takes a lot of time, it will become more natural for you as you continue applying it. Think about what you can take from the reading that will stay with you. Also, using these four stages will actually save you time because you will already have retained a lot, if not all, of the content, so when it is time to study for your exam, you will find that you already know the material.

Matching instructor expectations: Instructors are usually seeking deeper understanding as well as basic memory of concepts. Graphic features such as sidebars, diagrams, and charts help students understand complex information and distinguish between essential and inessential points. Identify one semester goal that will help you fulfill the long-term goal you just set.

Introduction to Key Concepts. Chapter 1. Outside of creative writing courses, most writing assignments are expository. Extra information: The key details directly explain the main idea. Not all details in a paragraph are equally important. What aspects of post-secondary education do you expect to find most challenging? Teachers may set aside some class time for reading and reviewing the material in depth. For many graduate students, especially those who have not attended university in a number of years, the thought of writing a page research paper is quite overwhelming.
